

Dress Code: A standardized dress code is the policy at FLS. Please see the First Lutheran School Handbook for details regarding school uniforms.

We realize that class size has an effect on the learning process. With our small class sizes, your child and teacher will be actively and enthusiastically involved in the learning process. Our family of teachers educates the whole child – spirit, mind, and body. The following guidelines are set:

Pre-Kindergarten: Must be 3 years old by September of the year entering. Maximum class size 15 with an assistant at 8.

Beginnergarten: Must be 4 years old by September of the year entering. Maximum class size 20 with an assistant at 8.

Kindergarten: Must be 5 years old by September of the year entering. Maximum class size 22 with an assistant.

Grades 1-3: Maximum class size 22 students.

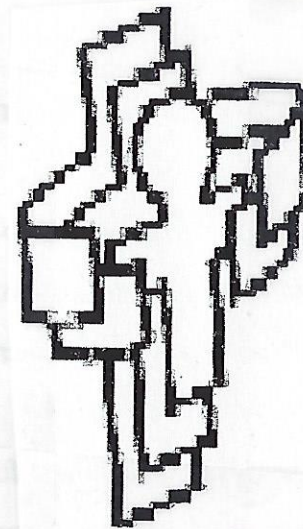
Grades 4-8: Maximum class size 27 students.

We are part of the Knoxville Independent School League.

After School Activities: Extra-curricular activities are a vital part of the total education program. While enhancing general knowledge, they develop wholesome attitudes and good human relations skills. First Lutheran sponsors several activities such as piano lessons, spelling bee, read-a-thon, and special student events. The 6th, 7th, and 8th grades each enjoy a class trip.
